Applications are being made for a loan for the permanent financing of our new facility. The loan amount requested is for \$1,250,000 with a 15 year amortization. A congregational meeting has been called by the Session for Sunday, March 18 for the purpose of considering the recommendation of the officers regarding the loan and to hear an update on the building from Benton Gibson.
