

## Nursery Guidelines for New Covenant Presbyterian Church

1. Only children birth through 3 years are allowed in the nursery. Children 4 and above are to go into their Sunday School class and church with their parents.
2. Children may only be picked up from the nursery by a parent. Children will not be released to come downstairs by themselves, with older siblings, or with other youth in the church. If they are not picked up by their parent, the parent might not realize that their child has come down. This is for the safety of our little ones.
3. Please do not come to the nursery until you are ready to pick up your child. This can upset your child if he sees you and you leave without picking him up. It can also upset others who are looking for their parents to pick them up.
4. Germs are very easily spread by our little ones and Mrs. Hilda does a wonderful job of keeping the toys in the nursery wiped down. However to help keep our kids well as much as possible please make sure your child is fever free for 24 hours before putting them in the nursery.
5. Please bring a diaper bag for your child with adequate supplies—wipes, diapers, sippy cup (with your child's name written on it), and snacks if necessary. The nursery has a back up supply of these items that are there for emergencies only.
6. Please make sure and inform Mrs. Hilda, or whoever is working in the nursery, if your child has any special needs. We will do our best to honor your wishes, but we cannot if we do not know what they are. Please let us know if your child has a food allergy that we need to be aware of.
